This qualification may also suit those with little or no vocational experience, but who possess sound theoretical business skills and knowledge that they would like to develop in order to create further educational and professional development opportunities.

They are required to develop site-specific work designs to ensure the implementation of the client's site requirements. They demonstrate the application of a broad range of technical, managerial, coordination, and planning skills.

Students will learn the calculation, estimation and measurement of foundations of civil construction projects. Students will also get an opportunity to establish required skill and knowledge in relation to detail drafting, technical specification and bills of quantities for the building projects.

- 7.** Credit Transfer Applications (if applicable):
 - A.** Previous and current academic testimonials
 - B.** Statements of attainment and academic records
 - C.** Resume/CV outlining work experience
 - D.** Letters or references from schools, training providers, or employers
- 8.** Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) (if you already have a valid policy)
